developmental screening - ppmd - your child's doctor may ask you questions or talk and play with your child during an exam to see how he or she learns, speaks, behaves, and moves. since there is no lab or blood test to tell if your child may have a delay, the developmental screening will help tell if your child needs to see a specialist. why is developmental screening important?
