**dewey decimal classification system** - the dewey decimal system is a hierarchical system, which means, within each broad class, it develops progressively from the general to the specific. for example: 600 technology (applied sciences) 640 domestic arts and sciences 646 sewing, clothing, personal grooming 646.7 personal grooming 646.72 personal appearance 646.724 care of hair

**how to find books using the dewey decimal classification ...** - books are assigned this number using the dewey decimal system. this is a hierarchical classification of topics. the system is made up of 10 main classes or categories, each divided into 10 secondary classes or subcategories, which in turn have 10 divisions of their own. in dewey, basic classes are organized by fields of study.
