**consensus statement on effective communication of urgent ...** - should be separate from critical results or panic-value policies in clinical pathology, with the expectation of a different time frame for communication.urgent diagnosis is defined as a medical condition that, in most cases, should be addressed as soon as possible significant, unexpected diagnosis is defined as a medical

**critical care of stroke - ucsf cme** - critical care of stroke. glucose  $\uparrow$  elevated serum glucose increases tissue necrosis and edema.  $\uparrow$  hyperglycemia  $>200\text{mg/dl}$  is a predictor of poor outcome in icu patients.  $\downarrow$  hypoglycemia (
