**diagnostic assessments - eriesd** - diagnostic assessments definition: a variety of assessment tasks that are used to determine students'™ level of knowledge, skills, and understandings at the beginning of a course, grade level, unit and/or lesson. they test the students on what they already know.

**introduction the purpose of assessment** - based on the diagnostic exam results, each student's™ deficiencies are determined, and each student is subsequently required to complete a computer-based mathematics tutorial program that is tailored to his or her specific difficulties. because the primary purpose of the diagnostic test is remediation, it is both un-graded and low-stakes.
